Walk Summary:	If you gaze out at the beautiful hills on the drive to the Buchan Caves Reserve, you will gain a sense of the hilly challenges, beauty and flora of the walk on offer. We start near the footy and netball reserve, and walk along the newly constructed pathway, past the natural swimming pool to the Caves Reserve. The Moon Hill Walk is steep and takes us to the perimeter of the park where we may see kangaroos or rock wallabies as we gaze from the lookout out over the township and at the rare Blue Wattle. Again, hills are the environmental theme as we negotiate our way on bush tracks and bushfire re-growth. We decend towards Spring Creek, crossing several creeks, stopping at the falls, and admiring views as we ascend the Tea Tree Walk before connecting with Caves Road and the Visitors Centre. If you would like to see the caves please book an afternoon tour at around 2:30 or later, but Parks require bookings, don't just turn up or you may not be able to get a viewing. They also are strict about seeing concession cards such as Seniors, or won't give the discount. Some quite steep hills and staircases, but can be done at your own pace.
